

FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

The Indwelling Christ

"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world" I John 4:4.

Christ living in us is the success by which we overcome sin and temptation. Jesus, at His coming, when He calls the righteous to inherit eternal life, probably will not ask for a dissertation regarding Bible truths, but of the transformed heart and life.

What are we to make of the opening verse: "He that is in you." How can we know whether or not Christ is dwelling in us. And how does Jesus dwell within us?

How do we know Christ is dwelling in us?

1. Love... Jesus says: John 13:35 "By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another."

2. Fruit... Matthew 7:20 "Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them." What kind of fruit? Gal 5:22-23 ". . . love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance." Ephesians 5:9 ". . . goodness and righteousness and truth;"

How does Christ dwell within us?

1. Holy Spirit... 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"

I Thessalonians 4:8 "He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us His Holy Spirit."

John 14:16 "And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with

you for ever;"

John 14:26 "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."

We are Christians. The definition of Christian is followers of Christ Jesus. Each one can examine his heart to see if he truly is a Christian by the above examples.

In other words if we harbor hate towards a fellow person we are not truly Christians. If we are impatient and intemperate could it be that we fall short of the high calling of God?

How can we have the heart change? Jesus tells us that if we open the door He will come in! And where Jesus dwells there is change.






PATHFINDER/ADVENTURER SABBATH




SPRING MUSIC PROGRAM


