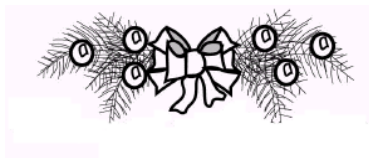

FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER



Hello Friends,

In the last few years we have experienced multiple disasters throughout the world, upon our nation, and of course upon our communities. We in the Southern Tier of New York have certainly had our share of crises, especially with the floods of 2006 and 2011. Think of the devastating fires that burned out of control this last summer in the western states. And, of course, the incredible devastation of Hurricane Sandy is still fresh on our minds. Is this the end? Is the great termination of earth's history as we know it about to happen? Or are these events, disastrous and heart-rending though they be, simply occurrences that have no special significance for our time?

To put it all in perspective, let's go back into history as it relates to Bible prophecy. It's a fact that devastating events have always been a part of our earthly experience. 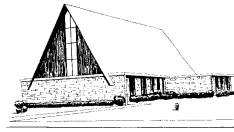

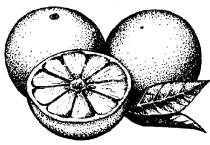
Please join us each Sabbath morning. Song service begins at 9:20. Classes are provided for adults and children. Mission DVDs are shown the last Sabbath of each month.
