FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Jesus tells us in John 10:10, "I have come that they may have life, and have it more abundantly." I've often wondered just what the Lord meant by this. What kind of "life" is He promising us?

As we read the context, we learn that He is referring to Himself as the "Good Shepherd," the One who calls, leads, protects, and lays down His life for His sheep. He contrasts Himself with the robber who tries to steal, harm, and destroy the sheep. The Good Shepherd loves His sheep, and does all to protect them from the encroachment of the robbers.



He gives them life; and not just life, but "life more abundantly." As I reflect upon what the more abundant life is, I must acknowledge that the status of being a Christian is a blessed condition indeed. While not being free from the trials and temptations that afflict us all, I have long known that being a follower of Jesus comes with great benefits. First of all comes the promise of eternal life. When Jesus

talked of the more abundant life, He was certainly referring to the fact that, in Him, we have an infinite future to look forward to. While we may yet die in this world, we have the wonderful hope of being resurrected at His Second Coming, changed into His incorruptible image, and dwelling in absolute happiness and fulfillment for eternity.

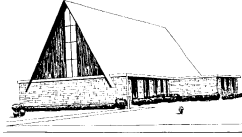
So the "life more abundantly" has to do with the eternal life Jesus promises us. But there's more. We have a better life even today, because of our accepting Jesus call to follow Him and be His sheep. Studies show that believing, practicing Christians enjoy a lot of advantages in this life over those who are not Christians. Over all, Christians have better marriages. We generally live longer and are in better health. We're more at peace with ourselves and our environment. We know the joy of forgiveness for our sins and the healing grace of God in our times of affliction. And, probably most important, we believe that God has a plan for our lives and for the universe, and that He will one day restore all things, including ourselves, to their original condition at creation. That means we know the conclusion of earth's history

is good, because the God we serve is trustworthy and good. That's what it means to have the more abundant life. May God help us to keep the "life more abundantly" in focus so that, even when it seems we are going through never-ending trials, we know God's going to write the final chapter on this

world, and, He going to do it soon.

BIBLE STUDY



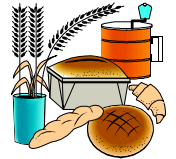
There is no Tuesday evening Bible Study during the summer months. We plan to resume following our evangelistic series.

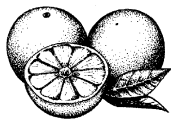
