SPIRITUAL SPOT

“Delight thyself also in the LORD; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart.” Psalm 37:4.

What does it mean to delight yourself in the Lord? “I have longed for Thy salvation, O LORD; and Thy law is my delight.” “I delight to do Thy will, O my God: yea, Thy law is within my heart.” Psalms 40:8; 119:174. David called God’s law his delight.

Jesus summed up God’s law in two great commandments. “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.” Matthew 22:37–39. Jesus also stated, “If ye love Me, keep My commandments.” John 14:15.

So to delight yourself in the Lord is to keep His commandments, to obey His law, out of your love for Him.

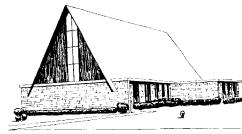
But why in verse 4 did the psalmist use the word *also*? “Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb. Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.” Psalm 37:1–3. That is because you must *also* not be jealous of the wicked and you must trust God to take care of you in every situation, for He promises you a better end.

When you have these characteristics, then God will give you your heart’s desires—desires that will build up and strengthen your relationship with Him and glorify the name of the Lord.

“Delight thyself also in the LORD; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.” Psalm 37:4, 5.

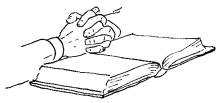
CHURCH NEWS

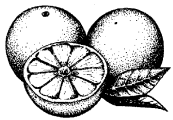
Labels Make Cents Program
